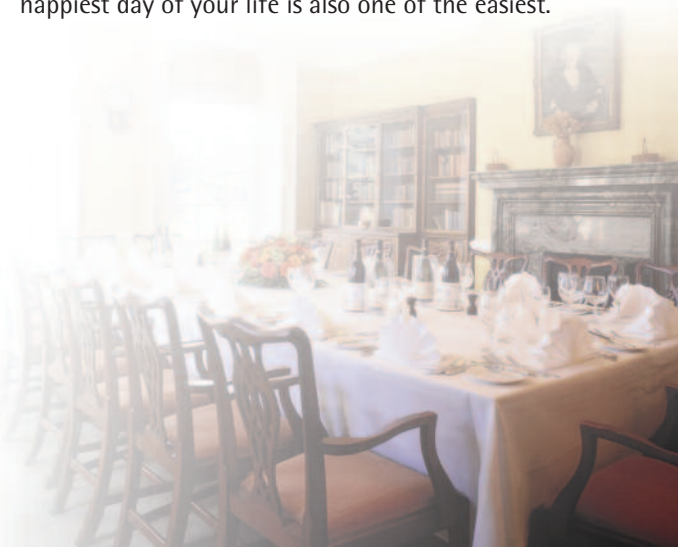

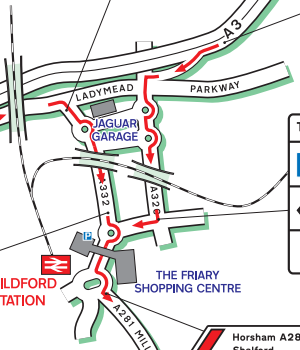

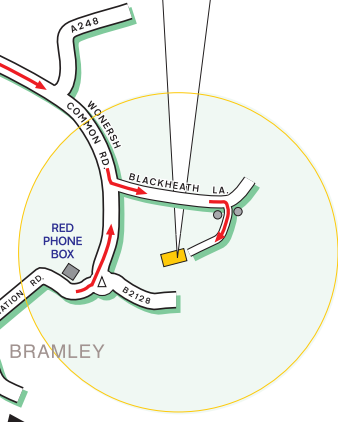

...by Road

Barnett Hill is set in peaceful, densely wooded Surrey countryside. The venue is four miles outside of Guildford and conveniently close to the M25 and M3, allowing easy access from all parts of the national motorway network.

...by Rail

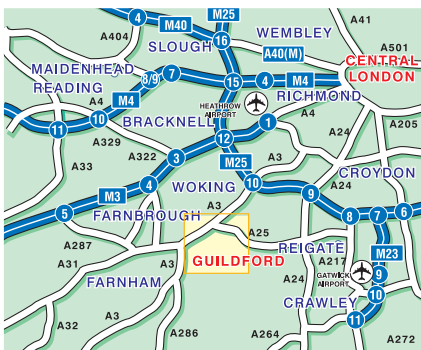
Guildford station, approximately half an hour from London Waterloo, is approximately 10-15 minutes away from Barnett Hill.
